## EDITOR'S NOTES

From now on, the magazine will only be published twice a year, once in midsummer and once just about Christmas. The responsibility for this decision rests, not with us, but with the School, who were finding the financial burden of three magazines a year a little too much for their strained resources. That's not to say that it doesn't come to us as a bit of a blessing, not only because it means less work for me, but because it gives the Treasurer rather more chance of making ends meet. Still apropos of the financial straits of the Association, which may be seen from even a cursory glance at the balance sheet which I have been asked to publish, we have decided to limit the number of circulars sent to members each year, and to endeavour to use these pages instead, where that is possible, for the purpose of notifying members of coming events. This may be rather a risky procedure, since some people appear to take even less notice of the magazine than of circulars; if I may quote an example, several people complained that they did not know about the Annual Dinner, because they had not received a circular, but each of them
